

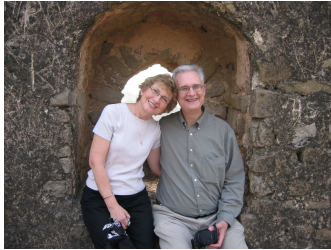

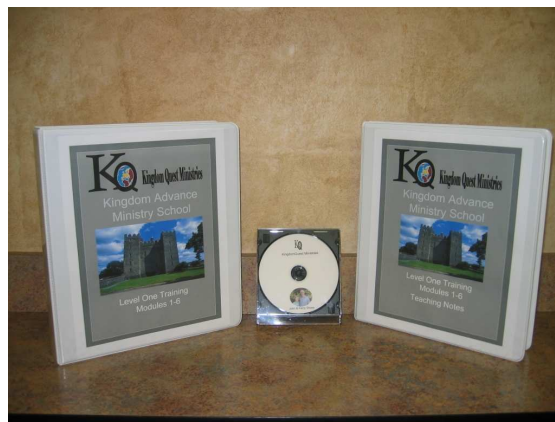

When we got home from India at the end of March, we looked at our schedule and wondered why the Lord had us in the USA until the end of August. However, as is always the case, God had great wisdom in putting together our schedule.

We had much writing to accomplish

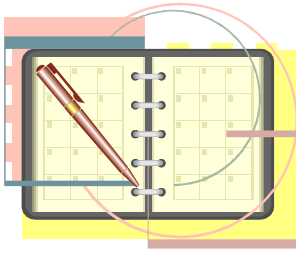
As we mentioned in our last newsletter, we wanted to adjust our Kingdom Advance School (KAS) teaching curricula in order for it to be clear to the nationals who will be teaching. This has meant that we need to do a rewrite of all six modules of our KAS teaching notes. We are adding purpose statements for each lesson and helps designed to assist teachers in passing on the truth contained in the lesson. This has been fun, but it's a larger task than we thought. We would like to have it completed by November when we return to India.

We are also developing the second level of KAS. This level will be for key leaders in the cities where we minister and will focus upon Kingdom Leadership, Kingdom Advance Prayer and Developing Strategies for the cities. This project is going well and the first module on leadership must be completed prior to our going in November because we will be teaching the material in two or three cities.

Developing relationships and sharing the ministry

About a year ago, one of our partners felt very impressed of the Lord that we should share the ministry of KQM with small groups. We have had the privilege of sharing KQM in a number of Christ Community Church's Life Groups, the Prime Timers Sunday School class and a KQM Informational Meeting. In addition to this, we have exercised hospitality and been invited to a number of homes. It has been good to make friends aware of the ministry and to minister to one another.

FUTURE MINISTRY

We do have some ministry opportunities coming up. June 11-13, we will teach workshops at Empowered 2008. This is the national conference of the Church Prayer Leaders' Network in Columbia, SC. We will also have a booth at the conference so we will be able to talk about KQM to people from all over the nation.

We head back to P-tan in August. We will take two small groups of leaders through Breaking Free and then give them pointers on how to teach it to others. They will each receive 15-20 copies in order to train other leaders in their region.

We head to India, November 2-21, where we will participate in two leaders modules of KAS (One will have leaders from five cities). Some of these leaders will eventually be added to our teaching faculty. We will also do Level II Module One in two (and perhaps three) cities.
